bunting kit

MATERIALS

- 5 - 10" x 5 1/2" fabric rectangles
- 3 - flower fabric
- 1 - 2 yard piece of twine

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fussy cut one square that surrounds a complete flower design (approx. 4 1/2" square).

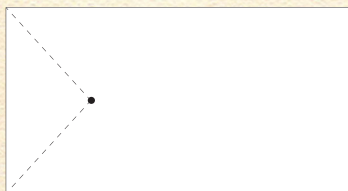
Cut a 4 1/2" square of ultra lightweight double-sided fusible interfacing.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Draw a line 2 1/2" from the center of one of the short sides of the rectangle fabric. Mark a dot.



Draw a diagonal line connecting the center dot with one of the corners. Do the same on the other corner.

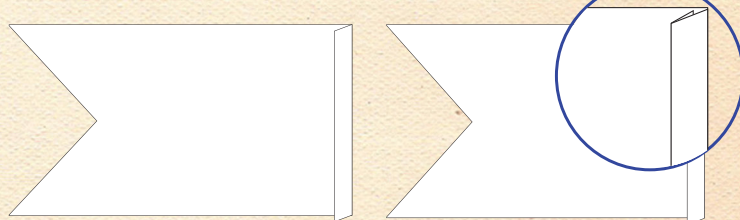


Cut across these diagonal lines with scissors.

Remove one of the paper sides of the interfacing and adhere to the wrong side of the flower fabric square. Fuse with iron following manufacturer's instructions. Cut around the flower shape. Remove the other paper side and position on the center front side of the rectangle fabric. Fuse in place with an iron.



To make the upper hem, fold 1/2" on the short end of the opposite side of the rectangle fabric.



Press. Fold another 1/2" pressing again. Stitch over the hem, close to the fold line. Make sure you are leaving an opening to thread the twine.

Make all the bunting flags needed in the same way you did the first.

Thread a long piece of twine (or tape it to a pencil) and thread through the pennants.

Make a loop at both ends for hanging.
